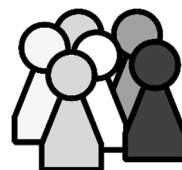


THANK YOU

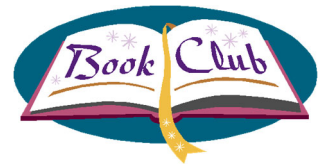
